Dear Parents

We have been asked to remind parents to be extra vigilant in the car park at all times but especially at the moment with the building work. If the fire alarm sounds when the gate is open, and you are in the Hollies playground, you will be asked to leave the playground and make your way on to Hazelbadge Road. You must wait there until the Hollies Gate is reopened. The Hollies gate will be locked.

If you are in the building you must leave by the nearest fire exit, the green back door and make your way on to the school playground. If you have left a younger child outside in a buggy, please go and collect them but leave with the other parents on to Hazelbadge Road. Do not re-enter the building.
